**Barbara Pozzo** is Full Professor of Comparative Law at the Faculty of Law of the University of Insubria in Como (Italy) since 2001, where she teaches Comparative Legal Systems, Gender Law in a comparative law perspective (UNESCO Chair Program), Legal Translation, Environmental law and Climate Change law, with a focus on liability of companies for environmental damage.

Since 2015 she is the Dean of the Law School of the Insubria University and Member of the National Conference of Law Schools' Deans, as well as of the European Law Faculties Association (ELFA).

Since 2016 she is the Coordinator of the international Ph.D program in "Law and Social Sciences".

In September 2018 she was awarded the UNESCO Chair on "Gender Equality and Women's Rights in the Multicultural Society", which is part of the Global Network of UNESCO Chairs on Gender and of the UNITWIN/UNESCO Chairs Programme.

She is the Director of the Summer School Program in Comparative Environmental Law, in association with the Universities of Utrecht (The Netherlands), Marseille/Aix-en-Provence (France) and Opole University (Poland).
